

RECYCLING FIRM'S STOCK CAN'T USE AMEX EXCHANGE REFUSES TO LIFT HALT IN TRADES COMPANY OFFICIAL IS ON TRIAL.(BUSINESS)

American Stock Exchange officials have refused to lift a suspension on trading of stock in North American Recycling Systems Inc. until the Fort Edward company discloses more information about its troubled financial status.

The Amex halted trading on the company on March 30, two weeks after North American reported it lost \$5.44 million in 1993. North American filed its annual report in March seven months after it was due and after one of its directors reportedly sold nearly 74,000 shares.

``We believe additional disclosure is necessary," Amex spokesman Tom Mariam said Friday. He refused to say what information ...
