"Yarnell Hill" Fire June 29, 10:00 <mark>a.m.</mark>

A series of small fires are burning approximately <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> mile north of mile post 272 at the bottom of Yarnell Hill.

There is <u>NO danger</u> to the Yarnell community at this time and there are <u>NO potential evacuation</u> orders contemplated at this time.

**Cause:** Unconfirmed – likely lightening **Number of Resources:** 40

2 crews 2 engines 2 air tankers 1 helicopter Acres involved: Unknown at this time Containment: 0% Injuries to Date: None

This fire, officially known as the "Yarnell Hill" Fire, is now being managed by the State Forestry Department. Yarnell Fire Department's Station is being used by State Forestry as a Staging Area.
