“Yarnell Hill” Fire

June 29, 10:00 **a.m.**

A series of small fires are burning approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ mile north of mile post 272 at the bottom of Yarnell Hill.

There is **NO** danger to the Yarnell community at this time and there are **NO** potential evacuation orders contemplated at this time.

Cause: Unconfirmed – likely lightning

Number of Resources: 40

2 crews 2 engines 2 air tankers 1 helicopter

Acres involved: Unknown at this time

Containment: 0%

Injuries to Date: None

This fire, officially known as the “Yarnell Hill” Fire, is now being managed by the State Forestry Department. Yarnell Fire Department’s Station is being used by State Forestry as a Staging Area.
